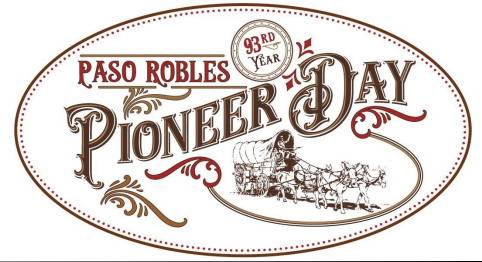

- D. During the parade, nothing is to be given away or thrown from entries.
- E. Forward motion is to be maintained at all times. Avoid large gaps between entries baring a safety concern.
- F. No air horns, fireworks or firearms should be discharged. (LOUD NOISES SCARE ANIMALS & CHILDREN).
- G. No alcoholic beverages allowed.
- H. All animals must be leashed/tethered and attended to at all times.
- I. Participants are responsible for cleaning up after their animals.
- J. All members of your group participating in the parade, or assisting your setup in the staging area, must sign the liability waiver attached hereto. Individuals under the age of eighteen (18) must have a parent or legal guardian sign the form. No exceptions will be allowed.
- K. Participants are required to yield right of way to all emergency vehicles.
- L. No person operating a motorized vehicle or any other moving equipment is permitted to use a cell phone, including texting, while on the parade route.
- M. Helmets must be worn by any rider/participant under the age of 18 on any scooter, bicycle, skate board, or similar device.
- N. All parade entries may be subject to inspection prior to and during the parade. If, for any reason, an entry is found to be hazardous or unsafe it must be modified to the satisfaction of the inspector or removed from the parade.
- O. All parade entries must be covered by liability insurance.

*Important information and logistical details for your participation will be emailed to you **AFTER** the closing date for parade entries. If you **DO NOT** receive your position detail by **one week prior** to the parade, contact the Parade Chair via email or Lori Woods, Vice-Chair via phone. Please note, all entries will be assigned their number with an attempt to keep the parade interesting and provide every participant a chance to be 'early', we encourage you to plan accordingly.*

Liability Waiver (Including General Release & Covenant Not to Sue):

This is a 2nd form and is not included in this 3 page entry/information form. Please be sure to complete and return prior to the parade.
